Born and raised in Ceylon, Ontario, Sharon's roots in Grey County go back to a time when one-room schools provided communities with their educational experiences.

From an early age, Sharon displayed a gift for writing and has been developing her poetic skills through a variety of occupational pursuits. Having retired from teaching in 2006, Sharon now enjoys life as a full-time poet and inspirational speaker.

One of Sharon's poems pays tribute to Mrs. Nuhn, the midwife who delivered over 1,000 babies in the local community. Sharon's parents both worked for Agnes Macphail. Her Grandfather, Archie Sinclair, was the station agent at the Flesherton Station in Ceylon when Agnes was Canada's first female Member of Parliament.
